GENERAL NOTES

- Ribbons and Prizes awarded to 6th place. First place prizes will be awarded for every class.
- All dogs MUST be leashed or crated except when competition require off-leash work.
- Please pick up your trash, clean up after your dogs and leave the grounds as clean as you found them.
- Absolutely no puppies under 3 months of age are allowed on the ground. Persons violating this rule will be asked to leave the trial grounds and will not receive a refund on any entry fees.
- Abuse of dogs or severe disciplining of dogs on trial grounds is strictly prohibited.
- For a complete list of rules, please see the General Rules section. Hot and Cold Food will be available at Site for purchase.
- Bitches in heat are **NOT** allowed on grounds.

PLEASE NOTE: In compliance with JRTCA policy, refunds will only be given for bitches in heat (must have veterinary note) or demise of terrier. No exceptions will be made.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

NORTHGATE FARM is located at 79 Mt. Lebanon Rd., Port Murray, NJ. If you use a GPS to get to Northgate, type the address as 79 Mount Lebanon Road, Glen Gardner, NJ using **Glen Gardner** as the town.

As you use the directions below, watch your odometer because roads are not well marked.

FROM NORTHEAST AND NYC:

I-80 West to exit 26, Rt. 46 West towards Budd Lake. Go 5.0 miles and turn left at the traffic light onto Naughright Rd. (it is called Sand Shore Road on the right side) There is an Exxon and Chrysler dealer on the corner. Go 2.7 miles and turn right onto Flocktown Rd. Take this to the end, 1.7 miles, and turn left onto Schooley's Mtn Rd. Take the first right onto Pleasant Grove Rd. (0.2 miles). Go 3.3 miles on Pleasant Grove Rd., turn left on Mt. Lebanon Rd. After 1.6 miles on Mt. Lebanon Rd., turn right into Northgate Farm.

From West/Northwest(PA/Poconos):

I-80 East to Exit 4. Take Rt. 46 East towards Hackettstown. After a few miles, you will turn right onto Rt. 31 going towards Washington. In Washington, turn left onto Rt 57. After 3 miles, you will turn right at a stoplight onto Point Mountain Rd. After 0.5 miles, you will go over another bridge and the road will fork. Stay to the left, on Pt. Mountain Rd. for another 2 miles. You will turn left at the top of the Mountain onto Mount Lebanon Rd. Northgate Farms is 0.5 miles on the left.

From the South:

178 to Rt 31 North (Clinton area in western NJ – about exit 17 on Rt 78). Take Rt. 31 North for 7.5 miles and turn right just after the McDonalds/A&P onto Rt 632 (Asbury-Anderson Rd.) Take this all the way to the end and turn right onto Rt. 57. You will only go 0.2 miles on Rt. 57 and you will turn right onto Pt. Mountain Rd. Go over the bridge, and when the road splits, stay to the left on Pt. Mountain Rd. You will go a total of 2.5 miles on Pt. Mountain Rd., and then turn left onto Mt. Lebanon Rd. (Old church and cemetery on corner). Northgate Farms in 0.5 miles on the left.

GENERAL RULES

- 1. All sanctioned classes are open to Jack Russell Terriers only.
- 2. Exhibitors and owners of terriers entered must be current JRTCA members and must not be a member of a conflicting JRT organization or register their JRTs in any all-breed registry or conflicting JRT organization. If an exhibitor is found to be in violation of this policy, entry will be disqualified and no refunds will be given. If a violation is confirmed after the trial, placements will be voided from all JRTCA records.
- 3. Exhibitors must submit a completed entry form including a signed waiver for every trial they enter. Entries must be within the 10-15" JRTCA height standard for all sanctioned classes (with the exception of pups who have not yet met the 10: height standard); measuring devices will be available on the trial grounds.
- 4. Puppies (under 12 months) are not eligible for championship in any division but heir own. Puppies are eligible to compete only if they have reached their fourmonth birthday (i.e. not 16 weeks). A puppy's age is the actual age the pup is on the day of the trial.
- 5. Bitches in season may not compete in any division. Pre-entry fees of bitches in season will be refunded with a veterinarian certificate or as otherwise agreed upon by the Trial Administrator.
- 6. Spayed or neutered terriers may compete in Miscellaneous Conformation. They may not compete in puppy, Family, Open or Working Conformation.
- 7. A terrier bred by a sanctioned JRTCA Judge may not be shown under that Judge in the Conformation division.
- 8. Terriers owned or co-owned by the Trial Chairperson or any member of their household may not be entered in any phase of the competition with the exception of Child and Youth Handling.
- 9. Terriers owned by judges may not be entered in any division in which they are judging but may enter the competition in any other division.
- 10. Terriers owned by stewards may be entered in any division provided that they find a substitute to perform their duties or have someone else show their terriers.
- 11. Requests for the measurement of a terrier being shown in any class may be made only by another exhibitor in that class or by the judge. These measurements will be considered the official height of the terrier in question. Requests made by spectators will not be honored. Only JRTCA height cards issues after September 1999 will be honored.
- 12. Excessive use of squeaky or fun-like baiting devices by exhibitors is prohibited in the Conformation ring and may result in the exhibitor being excused from the class. "Excessive use" will be at the Judge's discretion.
- 13. Exhibitors participating in the JRTCA Working Terrier Classes or Certificate Go-To-Ground must submit the appropriate JRTCA certificates with pre-entries or at the time of post entry. The Judge may require a copy of the certificate be presented to the ring/den steward at the time of judging. Registered terriers may submit a copy of NHC certificate signed by a JRTCA Working Judge within 30 days of the date it was issued.
- 14. Puppies under the age of three months are not permitted on the trial grounds. Any person violating this rule will be excused from all classes entered and asked to leave the trial site.
- 15. All dogs must be leashed or crated except when competition requires off-leash work. No liberty leashes allowed.
- 16. Overly aggressive dogs or an owner's failure to control his/her dog may result in disqualification at the discretion of the Judges or the Trial Administrator.
- 17. The abuse or server disciplining of dogs on the trial grounds is prohibited. Anyone displaying such behavior will be asked to leave the trial site and no entry fees will be refunded.
- 18. Dogs other than JRTs on the grounds may be excluded or permitted at the discretion of the Trial Administrator.
- 19. Exhibitors are responsible to double-check the classes they have entered and be on time. No refunds will be given for missed classes.
- 20. The owner/handler of a terrier entering any class does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by the rules of the JRTCA and the trial. A copy of the JRTCA Rule Book can be obtained by contacting the JRTCA office (410-561-3655) or it can be downloaded from the JRTCA website (www.terrier.com).
- 21. Unsportsmanlike conduct, or the use of foul and abusive language, will not be tolerated. Anyone demonstrating such conduct will be asked to leave the trial site and no entry fees will be refunded. In addition, such conduct will be subject to penalties, which may include the suspension of membership, restriction from entering the JRTCA National Trial, and/or fines. Trial Chairpersons have the right to refuse any entry at their sole and absolute discretion.
- 22. All dogs brought to JRTCA sanctioned trials must be current on vaccinations. No dogs of any age may be brought to a trial who have suspicion of contagious or infectious disease.

- Open to any dog 6 years & older. Judged on Breed Standard and the condition of the dog.
- Class 91 Veteran Bitch
- Open to any bitch 6 years & older. Judged on Breed Standard and the condition of the bitch.
- Class 92 BEST VETERAN AND RESERVE
- Open to 1st and 2nd place winners in classes 90 and 91

Class 93 Spay/Neuter

- Open to adult spayed terriers judged on Breed Standard
- Class 94 Suitability to Red Fox
- Class 95 Suitability to Groundhog
- Class 96 Suitability to Raccoon
- Class 97 BEST OF THE REST (Non-Sanctioned)
- Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of classes 93-96

Class 98 Tool Box Class

Open to handler with three adult Jack Russell Terriers at side; one suitable to each quarry (fox, groundhog, raccoon/badger). Placement based on the group the judge would choose to take hunting.

Class 99 My Best Friend (Non-Sanctioned) Open to all our IRT friends (Free if y

Open to all our JRT friends (Free if your dog was adopted from Russell Refuge or the Russell Rescue)

DIVISION C - YOUTH (FREE)

Class 100 Child Handler

Open to any youth aged 5 through 9 handling a JRT, 6 months or older. Judged on child's ability to present his/her dog and beginning knowledge of the Jack Russell. Quality of the dog NOT to be considered.

Class 101 Youth Handler

Open to any youth aged 10 through 16 handling a Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on youth's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of the Jack Russell Terrier. Quality of the dog NOT to be considered.

Class 102 Youth G-T-G

For youths aged 10-16 handling a Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on youth's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of Go-To-Ground. To be run through the 10-foot Novice liner; time not considered.

Class 103 YOUTH HIGH SCORE & RESERVE

Awarded to the Highest scoring youth and runner-up in Classes 101-102. The points are awarded as follows: 1st=8 points; 2nd=6 points; 3rd=5 points; 4th=4 points, 5th=3 points, 6th=2 points and participation=1 point.

DIVISION D-OBEDIENCE/RALLY SATURDAY ONLY 12:00 PM-3:00 PM

Will use companion dog sports obedience rules. Open to any adult terrier.

Class 104 Pre-Novice

10 max in each group, all commands on leash. To be judged individually: heel, heel fig 8, stand for exam, recall. Honor sit or down.

Class 105 Novice

To be judged individually: heel on leash, off lead fig 8, stand for exam, recall off leash. Honor sit or down.

Class 106 Open

To be judged individually: heel free, fig. 8, drop on recall, retrieve on flat, retrieve over high jump and broad jump.

RALLY OBEDIENCE

This is more relaxed than Drilled Obedience. Try your skills at this sport that consists of a sequence of numbered stations, where a sign indicates an obedience exercise that the team must perform.

- Class 107 Companion Rally—Open to any adult terrier. Performed on-lead. May be the same course as Rally I. This class is for the companion terrier that has little or no obedience training. A true beginner class. May not cross into Rally I or II.
- Class 108 Rally I On-Lead—Open to any adult terrier. Performed on-lead. Numbered course of 1-15 signs. Performed on loose lead at a normal walking pace. Must have some knowledge of obedience. May cross enter into Rally II.
- Class 109 Rally II Off-Lead—Open to any adult terrier. Performed off-lead. Numbered course of 15-18 signs. Course the same as Rally I with different or added exercises of more difficulty. May cross enter into Rally I.

Class 110 OBEDIENCE/RALLY BEST & RESERVE

The Obedience/Rally Best and Reserve will be awarded to the highest combined scores in Novice and Open Obedience and any Rally class. Rising Star Award—Given to the terrier/owner who shows the most promise in obedience as determined by the judge.

DIVISION F – GO-TO-GROUND

Go-to-Ground will begin at 11:00 am

Class 111 Pre-Novice Puppy

Open to Jack Russell puppies 4 up to 6 months. Entry in Pre-Novice Puppy class does not affect the puppy's eligibility to enter the Novice Class after 6 months of age. (One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter until quarry is reached; mark quarry for 15 seconds without a break in work and without leaving quarry).

Class 112 Novice Puppy

Open to Jack Russells 6 up to 12 months that have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open Puppy Class at this trial. (One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times until quarry is reached; when quarry is reached must work quarry continuously for a full 30 seconds without a break in work and without leaving the quarry; may switch from one type of work to another (examples: baying to concentrated stare or digging to baying).

Class 113 Open Puppy

Open to Jack Russells 6 up to 12 months that have scored 100% in a Novice Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. Not open to any puppies that have previously achieved 100% in this class. Puppies earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Puppy Championship GTG class at this trial. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter before quarry is reached; must work quarry continuously for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry; may switch from one type of work to another.)

Class 114 Puppy Championship

Open to Jack Russells, 6 up to 12 months that have earned 100% in an Open Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. A copy of a 100% Open score sheet shall be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Puppy Go-To-Ground Champion and Reserve. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter before the quarry is reached; when quarry is reached must work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry; may switch from one type of work to another.)

Class 115 Novice Adult

Open to Jack Russells one year of age or older that have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open class at this trial. (One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times until quarry is reached; must work quarry. Continuously for a full 30 seconds without a break in work and without leaving the quarry; may switch from one type of work to another (examples baying to concentrated stare or digging to baying.)

Class 116 Open Adult

Open to Jack Russells one year or older that have scored 100% in a Novice Go-To- Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter before the quarry is reached; must work quarry continuously for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry; may switch from one type of work to another.)

Class 117 12 and ↑, 10" up to 15" GTG (non-sanctioned, cannot cross-enter Seniors) ★

Open to any adult Jack Russell 10" up to 15", 12 years and over. No trial certificate required. (30 seconds to quarry. May not leave the earth. Work quarry for 1 minute.)

DIVISION F – GO-TO-GROUND, CONTINUED

Certificate Classes: Open to any adult Jack Russell one year and over, which holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Go-To-Ground Champion and Reserve. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.)

Class 118 10 up to 121/2" Adult Championship Certificate

Class 119 Over 121/2 up to 15" Adult Championship Certificate

- Class 120 10 up to 121/2 Veteran Championship Certificate
- Class 121 Over 121/2 up to 15" Veteran Championship Certificate
- Class 122 10 up to 121/2 Senior Championship Certificate
- Class 123 Over 121/2 up to 15" Senior Championship Certificate

DIVISION G – SUPER EARTH

A challenging GTG course with a series of false entrances and/or false tunnels and dens. Open to any Jack Russell Terrier, 1 year and older. 30 seconds per 30 feet of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave and re-enter earth several times until the quarry is reached then must work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry. May switch from one type of work to another without penalty.

NOTE: In order to keep Super Earth moving efficiently, for those of you who have multiple terriers, please alternate with the other people in line. Thank you!

Class 124 Open Adult

Open to adult JRTs one year and older that have scored 100% in open Super Earth class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. 90 seconds to reach quarry.

Class 125 Adult Champion Super Earth Certificate 10" up to 12 1/2"

Open to any adult JRT 10" up to 12 ½", 1 year and over which holds a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate. 30 seconds per 30 feet of tunnel to reach the quarry; may leave the earth and re-enter several times; work for 1 minute. A copy of the Certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Adult 10" up to 12 ½" Super Earth Champion and Reserve.

Class 126 Adult Champion Super Earth Certificate 12 1/2" up to 15"

Open to any adult JRT 12 ½" up to 15", 1 year and over which holds a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate. 30 seconds per 30 feet of tunnel to reach the quarry; may leave the earth and re-enter several times; work for 1 minute. A copy of the Certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Adult 12 ½" up to 15" Super Earth Champion and Reserve.

Class 127 Veteran Champion Super Earth Certificate 10" up to 12 1/2"

Open to any Veteran JRT 10" up to 12 ½", 6 years and over which holds a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate. 30 seconds per 30 feet of tunnel to reach the quarry; may leave the earth and re-enter several times; work for 1 minute. A copy of the Certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Veteran 10" up to 12 ½" Super Earth Champion and Reserve.

Class 128 Veteran Champion Super Earth Certificate 12 ½" up to 15"

Open to any Veteran JRT 12 $\frac{12}{2}$ " up to 15", 6 years and over which holds a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate. 30 seconds per 30 feet of tunnel to reach the quarry; may leave the earth and re-enter several times; work for 1 minute. A copy of the Certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Veteran 12 $\frac{12}{2}$ " up to 15" Super Earth Champion and Reserve.

Class 129 Senior Champion Super Earth Certificate 10" up to 12 1/2"

Open to any Senior JRT 10" up to 12 1/2", 9 years and over which holds a JRTCA Super Earth

Trial Certificate. 30 seconds per 30 feet of tunnel to reach the quarry; may leave the earth and re-enter several times; work for 1 minute. A copy of the Certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Senior Super Earth Champion and Reserve.

Class 130 Senior Champion Super Earth Certificate 12 ½" up to 15"

Open to any Senior JRT 12 ½" up to 15", 9 years and over which holds a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate. 30 seconds per 30 feet of tunnel to reach the quarry; may leave the earth and re-enter several times; work for 1 minute. A copy of the Certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Senior Super Earth Champion and Reserve.

Class 131 12 and ↑, 10" up to 15" Super Earth (non-sanctioned, cannot cross-enter Seniors) ★

Open to any JRT ages 12 and up, 10" up to 15", no JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate needed to enter. 30 seconds per 30 feet of tunnel to reach the quarry; may leave the earth and re-enter several times; work for 1 minute.

DIVISION H: FUN & FIELD

FASTEST TIME OF THE DAY AND RESERVE TO BE AWARDED EACH DAY FOR BARN HUNT.

SECTION 1: BARN HUNT (Non-Sanctioned)

As the name implies, this event takes place in a closed in barn-in the hay bales. You and your terrier must work together to locate the quarry (Rats)! Terrier must locate, and work the rats as in GTG, but you might need to help them along the way!

- Class 132 Puppies, 6 up to 12 months
- Class 133 Adults, 1 year and older, 10" up to 12 $^{\prime\!\prime}$
- Class 134 Adults, 1 year and older, 12 $\%^{\prime\prime}$ up to 15"

SECTION 2: LURE COURSING (Non-Sanctioned)

FASTEST TIME OF THE DAY AND RESERVE TO BE AWARDED EACH DAY FOR LURE COURSING (Unders) and (Overs).

No training or experience needed. Lure Coursing is a timed event with the terrier chasing the lure. Event is designed for all terriers to participate regardless of skill level or previous experience. Fastest time of two runs qualifies.

- Class 139 Puppies, 6 up to 12 months
- Class 140 Adults, 1 year and older, 10" up to 12 1/2"
- Class 141 Adults, 1 year and older, 12 1/2" up to 15"
- Class 142 Veterans, 6 years and older, 10" up to 12 1/2"
- Class 143 Veterans, 6 years and older, 12 $\frac{12}{2}$ up to 15"
- Class 144 Seniors, 9-11 years, 10" up to 12 ½"
- Class 145 Seniors, 9-11 years, 12 1/2" up to 15"
- Class 146 12 and \uparrow , 10" up to 12 ½" \star
- Class 147 12 and ↑, 12 ½" up to 15" ★

SECTION 3: BALL RETRIEVAL (Non-Sanctioned)

You may use you own ball or use ours. Judged on best retrieval time out of three tries.

Class 148 Puppies, 6 up to 12 months

Class 149 Adults, 1 year and older, 10" up to 12 $\rlap{k}2''$

Class 150 Adults, 1 year and older, 12 ½" up to 15"

Class 151 Veterans, 6 years and older, 10" up to 15"

Class 152 Seniors, 9-11 years, 10" up to 15"

Class 153 12 and ↑, 10" up to 15" ★

SECTION 4: AGILITY GAMES (Non-Sanctioned)

These games are designed to test your terrier's agility ability in a fun and refreshing way! Come try something new, or hone your skills in a trial like setting! Please note: There will be no food allowed in the ring! All classes can be run on or off lead! 5 point fault for running the course on-lead! Classes will be divided by height if entries warrant! All veteran dogs (6 years and older) can jump at 4"!

Saturday

Class 154 Game #1: Full-house: On & Off Lead

The objective is to accumulate the highest amount of points within the allotted time. This is a time-limit game - collect points until the buzzer sounds, the dog has 5 seconds to make it back over the start line. The clock will stop when any part of dog crosses the start line. The terrier must successfully complete three single jumps, two "circle" obstacles (tunnel, chute, tire jump) and one Joker (weaves, double jump, teeter, or A-frame). You will have 40 seconds to complete the required "Full-house" and collect as many more points as you can. Five faults for running course on-lead.

Class 155 Game #2: Tunnelers: On & Off Lead

The Tunnelers class is a numbered course comprised of only tunnels. The goal of the Tunnelers class is to demonstrate the dog's ability to respond quickly to directional commands from the handler while negotiating a course comprised of only tunnels. Five faults for running course on-lead; five faults for an off-course; and fifteen faults for a missed obstacle.

Sunday

Class 156 Game #1: Colors: On & Off Lead

A minimum of 8 and maximum of 12 obstacles per course are placed within the ring. The terrier must complete all obstacles in the prescribed sequence marked by the cones. The objective of Colors is to run one of two over- lapping mini-agility courses of 8 to 12 obstacles, which will be fairly equal in terms of length and challenge. Each course will be marked by a different set of colored cones. Five faults for running course on-lead; five faults for an off-course; and fifteen faults for a missed obstacle.

Class 157 Game #2: Jumpers: On & Off-Lead

This class consists of 12-17 jumps and/or tunnels with at least one lead change. Scoring is time plus faults, with lowest score getting 1st regardless of number of faults. Five faults for running course on-lead; five faults for knocked bar, and off-course; and fifteen faults for a missed obstacle.

Agility High Score and Reserve will be awarded to the high score terrier and runner up with the highest combining scores of the 4 games. No entry fee. Ties to be broken by the fastest time in Jumpers.
